










COMPONENTS OF AN OPEN DATA PLATTFORM



GOVDATA – THE DATA PORTAL FOR GERMANY

The national portal offers:

- Coherent access to re-usable data from the federal, state and local level in Germany
- Additionally documents and apps can also be published via GovData
- Search functionalities allow for finding relevant data sets
- Distinct descriptions allow users to easily tell whether a data set is e.g. under open licences, who the data provider is or in which data formats the data is accessible
- Data providers can publish open and restricted data via GovData
- Participation of data providers is voluntary






ARCHITECTURE OF GOVDATA

HARVESTING & DATA PROVISION

- Great heterogeneity among data providers:
- 4 options for data providers
 - Harvesting/Mining via CSW/ISO19115 (Geo data catalog, PortalU, destatis)
 - Harvesting CKAN/JSON (Berlin, Hamburg, Bremen)
 - Active provision via REST-API (Bayern)
 - Alternative: Manual registering
- 1 Meta data structure (JSON, CKAN-compatible)



METADATA STRUCTURE OF GOVDATA

- Continous development of meta data structure
 - Especially reference to original meta data and original catalog
 - Definition of categories
 - Current version accessible via https://github.com/fraunhoferfokus/ogd-metadata
- Transparent, cooperative maintenance via version control:
 - Change requests can be published easily
 - · History is documented
 - Current status is always visible
- Small changes, especially in lists are presumable





DATA LICENCE GERMANY - DATENLIZENZ DEUTSCHLAND

- The federal-state-level working group "Open Government" developed standard use regulations for the provision and usage of data.
- Version 1.0 was published January 2013, Version 2.0 in July 2014

 - Open usage regulation
 - Condition of attribution
