

A “best practice” catalogue for funders

- all funding institutions seem to agree that transparency and dissemination of methodology, data, and results is warranted and important
- yet, funding agreements seldom include the obligation to publish data or model code under an open license
- practical goal of this break-out group: compile a list of 4-8 bullet points with demands (or “recommendations”) for funding bodies
- strategic goal of this break-out group: establish the *openmod initiative* as a visible interest group for openness and transparency and the primary counterpart for funding bodies which seek advise on these matters
